


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

With steadily growing demand for business, in 2009 VHV Group needed an external service provider for support in the day-to-day handling of existing insurance files. Rhenus therefore took over more than 35,000 running meters of files. At the same time, an inventory structure had to be developed and storage had to be created, as approx. 100 files are accessed on a daily basis.

In addition, Rhenus Archiv Services GmbH in Hannover archives the customer's data media, microfiche and microfilms and makes them available in digital form if required. Rhenus also takes care of processing incoming mail, inventorying, storage, dispatching, digitalization and the processing of insurance claims as well as the destruction of archive holdings.





THE CHALLENGE

The goal of the order execution is to guarantee the access of the employees of VHV Group to the current insurance contracts in the shortest possible time by means of a central file management at the facilities of Rhenus Archiv Services GmbH.

This enables a timely and fast inventorization of the new additions as well as, if necessary, a quick provision of the files in physical form directly to the clerk.
